

Top global experts to discuss roadmap for a peaceful, just and inclusive recovery from COVID-19

Virtual Conference co-organized by UN DESA, IDLO and the Government of Italy

28-30 APRIL 2021

ROME, 21 April 2021 – High-level government, UN and international organizations officials, leading academics, civil society and youth representatives from around the world will convene virtually on 28-30 April 2021 for the second <u>Conference on Sustainable Development Goal 16</u> on peace, justice and strong institutions, co-organized by the UN Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA), the International Development Law Organization (IDLO) and the Government of Italy.

Building on the first <u>SDG 16 Conference in Rome, Italy in 2019</u>, the 2021 Conference on SDG 16 will assess how the COVID-19 pandemic has affected progress towards <u>SDG 16</u> and the wider <u>2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development</u>. The conference will highlight the importance of building resilience to shocks and discuss a roadmap for a more just, inclusive and equitable recovery.

Outcomes of the Conference will contribute to the deliberations of this year's <u>High-level</u> <u>Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF)</u> taking place in July 2021.
