Mr. Alessandro de Pedys, Director General for Public and Cultural Diplomacy, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Italy

Alessandro de Pedys graduated in International Economics cum laude from the University of Roma La Sapienza. In 1989, he began his diplomatic career with an assignment to the Foreign Ministry's Directorate General for Political Affairs and then he served as Chief of Staff of the Service for Legal Affairs, Diplomatic Disputes and

International Agreements.

In 1992, he served as First Secretary in the Economic and Commercial Office at the Embassy of Italy in Seoul. Following this, in 1996, he was Counselor in the Political and Press Office at the Embassy of Italy in London.

In 2000, he served for two years as Head of the Foreign Press Office at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In 2002, he became Deputy Head in the Sherpa Office for Italian Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

From 2004 to 2007, he was assigned to the Diplomatic Advisor Office to the Presidency of the Italian Republic.

In 2007, he was Consul General in Hong Kong and Macau.

In 2010 he was appointed Chief of Staff of the Undersecretary of State and then of the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs.

From 2014 to 2018 he was Ambassador of Italy to the Republic of Poland.

From 2018 to 2020 he was Diplomatic Advisor to the Minister of Economy and Finance.

From February 2020 to July 2021 he was appointed Head of International Relations at Leonardo SpA.

From 1 June 2023, he is Director General for Public and Cultural Diplomacy.
