She currently works as Legal Officer with ARTICLE 19 in London (UK), a global free speech organisation, where she focuses on transparency, access to information, anticorruption, sustainable development and gender.

Before joining ARTICLE 19 in 2019, she worked a legal researcher for Columbia Global Freedom of Expression covering the case-law of the European regional courts (European Court of Human Rights and the

Court of Justice of the European Union). Previously, she gained experience in the field of freedom of expression, protection of journalists and media policy by working at UNESCO, Media Defence, the World Association of Newspapers and News publishers (WAN-IFRA) and Oxygen for Information (Ossigeno per l'Informazione).

Ilaria holds a Masters of Law (LL.M) in Human Rights Law from the University of London (UCL) and a Master's Degree in International and European Law (JD) from the University of Turin (Italy).
