Mr. Diego García-Sayán

Former UN Special Rapporteur on the independence of judges and lawyers

Mr. Diego García-Sayán is the former Special Rapporteur of the United Nations on the Independence of Judges and Lawyers (2016 – 2022). He

was a judge of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights until 31
December 2015, and its President for two consecutive terms. He has
broad experience in multilateral organizations at the United Nations
and the Organization of American States, including as: (i)
Representative of the UN Secretary General for the Peace Agreements
at El Salvador and for the subsequent verification of the agreements
reporting directly to the Security Council; (ii) Chairperson of the UN
Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances; (iii)
Member of the Redesign Panel on the United Nations System of
Administration of Justice, appointed by the UN Secretary General (2006); (iv)
of the Electoral Mission of the OAS in Guatemala in the general elections (2007).

He was also appointed by the Secretary General (2017) to conform the "Comité de Escogencia" in Colombia that appointed all the members of the transitional justice and of the Truth Commission following the Peace Agreements between FARC and the Colombian Government. Mr. García-Sayán was Minister of Justice during the democratic transition in Peru. In his capacity as Minister of Foreign Affairs, he proposed and promoted the Inter-American Democratic Charter adopted in the Lima General Assembly (Sept. 11, 2001).
