Lovro Tomasic was born in Zagreb, Croatia, and practices law as a notary in Erlangen, Germany. He studied law at the universities of Regensburg (Germany) and Cambridge (U.K.) and completed his

doctorate thesis on a topic of European private law and legal theory at the University of Munich in 2013. He has worked as a notary candidate since 2012 and was appointed as notary in 2015.

Lovro has been involved in internationial notarial cooperation as a representative of the Bundesnotrarkammer since 2016 with a particular focus on his region of origin, South Eastern Europe. He has held a leading role in several projects of international cooperation with the FAO and the German development organisations GIZ and IRZ. Lovro has been a member of the working group "Partnership with International Organisations" of the UINL since 2017 and is a member of the Steering Committee of the UINL.
