Charlotte Le Faucheur is a French/Dutch national, who currently works at Cordaid, one of the biggest non-governmental organization in The Netherlands. Simultaneously, she collaborates as a program associate with the Civil Society Platform for Peacebuilding and Statebuilding (CSPPS) which is hosted and coordinated by Cordaid.

Ms. Le Faucheur pursued her academic journey at The Hague, focusing on International Public Policy and Leadership Studies, where she also completed minors in Non-Profit Building and Management, as well as Development, Cooperation and Globalization. During her studies, she completed an exchange program at La Sorbonne in Paris, specialising in International Law.

Charlotte's commitment to social causes is demonstrated through her work with JIP, a non-profit organization created by the Amsterdam municipality to support children in need of advice, particularly those facing challenging circumstances. She also volunteered with Amnesty International, participating in the "Let's Talk About Yes" campaign, which successfully led to a new law proposal against sexual violence, defining it based on consent in the Dutch Sexual Offences Act, on March 19, 2024.
