ANNEX C TERMS OF REFERENCE / TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

A. About IDLO

The International Development Law Organization (IDLO) is an intergovernmental organization exclusively devoted to promoting the rule of law. Established in 1983, IDLO works to enable governments and empower people to reform laws and strengthen institutions to promote peace, justice, sustainable development and economic opportunity. Its programs, research and policy advocacy cover the spectrum of rule of law from peace and institution building to social development and economic recovery in countries emerging from conflict and striving towards democracy.

The Assembly of Parties is IDLO's highest decision-making body. It is composed of Representatives of all Member Parties, which have joined the Establishment Agreement of IDLO. IDLO currently has 37 Member Parties.

IDLO has its Headquarters in Rome, a Branch Office in The Hague, Liaison Offices for the United Nations in New York and Geneva, and Country Offices in Afghanistan, Armenia, the Bahamas, Burkina Faso, Honduras, Indonesia, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Jordan, Liberia, Mali, Mexico, Moldova, Mongolia, Myanmar, Niger, the Philippines, Somalia, Tunisia, Uganda and Ukraine.

B. Background

The purpose of this procurement is to provide reliable daily Road Transportation Passenger Services for the IDLO Liberia Country Office (LCO) to enable it to fulfil its mission. The Contractor will facilitate timely transportation of staff and IDLO partners to various IDLO functions or activities within the Monrovia city and its environs. Some of these activities will include taking staff to and from trainings, meetings and running IDLO errands.

C. Conditions of Contract and Expected Output

IDLO is looking to engage able and qualified Suppliers to provide **Road Transport Passenger Services Within Monrovia City**. IDLO seeks to enter into a Service Contract.

Passenger on board the vehicle will monitor the logbook to be supplied by the Contractor. Passenger will sign on before pick up, at every destination, and sign when drop off by passenger on board. The Finance and Administrative Manager shall have a monthly review to track the movement of the vehicle in or out of Monrovia and monitor the fuel consumption.

IDLO will be responsible to provide fuel and log sheet to monitor mileage while in the field.

The Contractor is responsible for the provision of Vehicles, Drivers and Maintenance Services of the Vehicles.



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In consultation with the Supplier, IDLO shall establish a system for performance measurement based on the Service Levels and **Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)** as stated below:

F. Work Location

Services are to be delivered within the city of Monrovia, Liberia.

Frequently visited areas include: Central Monrovia, UN Drive, Tubman Boulevard, Mamba Point, Capitol Hill, etc.



The Contractor will also occasionally be asked to provide Airport Shuttle Services.

G. Qualifications of the Successful Contractor

 - b) The Supplier shall have at least 3 Years of working experience as Vehicle Rental Services in Liberia with UN or other international equivalent organizations.
 - c) The Supplier shall provide a brief company profile with reference to Business Owners, years of operations in Liberia, main office and branches, number of vehicles and types of vehicles, client list, number of staff working in the office.
