1		For the conversion courses (Basic, Intermediate, Advanced), what will be input provided to vendor? Is it an existing courses in SCORM format OR input will be PPT/Word files OR PPT based training document?	For course conversions, depending on specific requirements and asset availability, some may already be housed in the institution's LMS (Moodle, Thinkific). It is possible that some modules are already in SCORM format, while others may be in Microsoft file format; some may simply be in the multimedia content format (pdf, jpg, png, mp4, etc).
2	Section D Page 16 Custom Development Course: Description: Courses requiring the creation of new content or significant adaptation of existing materials to meet specific learning objectives and organizational requirements. Characteristics:	a. Does "tailored content creation from scratch" mean research and curation of content from various online resources? b. Will this type of work require Subject Matter Expertise OR will SME support will still be provided by IDLO?	The tailored content creation will be done in close collaboration with the subject matter experts provided by IDLO, and SMEs of the partner institutions. For custom development courses, it is expected that the vendor may be designing original static and interactive content from scratch, depending on specific requirements, but it is also possible to source assets

Are all services expected to be provided remotely? Will travel be required?		The service is anticipated to be executed and delivered to IDLO Philippines, situated in Rockwell Center, Makati City, Philippines. While certain phases of the elearning course development may be conducted remotely, it is essential that the training sessions be conducted in person at a venue arranged by IDLO. There are no language requirements, aside from English.
