ANNEX A INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1.	General Considerations	In preparing the Bid, the Bidder is expected to examine the ITB in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested in the ITB may result in rejection of the Bid. The Bidder will not be permitted to take advantage of any errors or omissions in the ITB. Should such errors or omissions be discovered, the Bidder must notify IDLO.
2.	Cost of the Bid	The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Bid. IDLO will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the solicitation.
3.	Currency of Bid	Bids shall be nominated exclusively in Uganda Shillings.
4.	Language of the Bid	The Bid and all correspondences and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and IDLO shall be written in the English language.
5.	Delivery Term and Place	Services will be delivered within set delivery days after receipt of Work Order from IDLO to IDLO Uganda Country office located at Plot 9 Naguru Drive.
6.	Deadline for Submissions of Bids	The Bid shall be addressed to IDLO on or before Date: February 26, 2024 Time: 15:00 hours Rome, Italy local time. Note: Proposals submitted by email must be limited to a maximum of 10MB, virus-free and no more than two email transmissions. They must be free from any form of virus or corrupted contents, or the quotations shall be rejected.
7.	Documents comprising the Bid	 The Bid shall comprise the following components: 1. Bid Submission Form (see Annex D); 2. Bidder Information Form (see Annex E) 3. Price Schedule (Annex F)
8.	Contents of solicitation documents	The Bidder is expected to examine all corresponding instructions, forms, terms and specifications contained in the Solicitation Documents. Failure to comply with these documents will be at the Bidder's risk and will affect the evaluation of the Bid.

10. Amendments of solicitation documents	At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Bids IDLO may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Solicitation Documents by amendment.

15. Validity Period of Bids	All Bids will be valid for 90 days from the deadline for submission of Bids. In exceptional circumstances IDLO may request the Bidders to extend the validity of the Bid beyond what has been initially indicated in this ITB. The Bidders shall be invited to confirm the extension in writing, without any modification whatsoever on the Bid. The Bidders may choose not to extend the validity period of the Bid upon request of IDLO.
16. Modification and withdrawal of Bids	The Bidder may modify/withdraw its Bid after the Bid's submission, provided that written notice of the withdrawal is received by IDLO prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of Bids. The Bidder's modification/withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of clause Deadline for Submission of Bids. No Bid may be modified nor withdrawn after to the deadline for submission of Bids. No Bid may be modified/withdrawn in the Interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified by the Bidder in the Bid Submission Form.
17. Amendment of the Bid	At any time prior to the deadline of Bid submission, IDLO may for any reason, such as in response to a clarification requested by a Bidder, modify the ITB in the form of an amendment to the ITB. Amendments will be made available to all prospective bidders. If the amendment is substantial, IDLO may extend the Deadline for submission of bid to give the Bidders reasonable time to incorporate the amendment into their Bids.

21. Evaluation of Eligibility and Qualification	 In general terms, Bidders that meet the following criteria may be considered qualified: a) They are not included in IDLO Sanctions lists (EU, US, UN); b) They have a good financial standing and have access to adequate financial resources to perform the contract and all existing commercial commitments, c) They have the necessary similar experience, technical expertise, production capacity where applicable, quality certifications, quality assurance procedures and other resources applicable to the provision of the services required; d) They are able to comply fully with IDLO General Terms and Conditions of Contract and IDLO Supplier Code of Conduct; e) They do not have a consistent history of court/arbitral award decisions against the Bidder; and f) They have a record of timely and satisfactory performance with their clients.
22. Price variation	Bidders shall not vary their prices for any reason after the deadline of the tender and while the Bid is still valid.
23. Preliminary Screening	IDLO will screen the Bids' Annex D and E to determine whether they are complete, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the Bid is generally in order.
24. Correction of errors	In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected by IDLO. If the Bidder does not accept the final price based on IDLO's correction of errors, its Bid will be rejected.
25. Due Diligence	 IDLO reserves the right to undertake a due diligence exercise aimed at determining to its satisfaction, the validity of the information provided by the Bidder. Such exercise shall be fully documented and may include, but need not be limited to, all or any combination of the following: a) Verification of accuracy, correctness and authenticity of information provided by the Bidder; b) Validation of extent of compliance to the ITB requirements

ANNEX C TERMS OF REFERENCE / TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

A. About IDLO

The International Development Law Organization (IDLO) is an intergovernmental organization exclusively devoted to promoting the rule of law. Established in 1983, IDLO works to enable governments and empower people to reform laws and strengthen institutions to promote peace, justice, sustainable development and economic opportunity. Its programs, research and policy advocacy cover the spectrum of rule of law from peace and institution building to social development and economic recovery in countries emerging from conflict and striving towards democracy.

The Assembly of Parties is IDLO's highest decision-making body. It is composed of Representatives of all Member Parties, which have joined the Establishment Agreement of IDLO. IDLO currently has 37 Member Parties.

IDLO has its Headquarters in Rome, a Branch Office in The Hague, Liaison Offices for the United Nations in New York and Geneva, and Country Offices in Afghanistan, Armenia, the Bahamas, Burkina Faso, Honduras, Indonesia, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Jordan, Liberia, Mali, Mexico, Moldova, Mongolia, Myanmar, Niger, the Philippines, Somalia, Tunisia, Uganda and Ukraine.

The work of IDLO is sustained by a dynamic, diverse, multinational and multicultural workforce, comprised of over 400 employees plus additional personnel in the non-employee category such as consultants and interns. About one fourth of the IDLO workforce is based in its Headquarters in Rome, while the rest are spread across the globe in our Branch and Country offices.

B. Background

The purpose of this procurement is to provide reliable **Road Transport Passenger Services Within and Outside Kampala** for the IDLO Uganda Country Office (UCO) to enable it to fulfil its mission. The reliable transportation will facilitate timely transportation of staff and IDLO partners to various IDLO functions or activities within the Kampala CBD and other cities and districts within Uganda on an occasional basis. Some of these activities will include taking staff to and from trainings, meetings and running IDLO other official errands.

C. Condition of Contract and Expected Output

IDLO is looking to establish one or several Framework Agreement(s) with able and qualified service providers. A Framework Agreement is a type of agreement with its terms and conditions under which procurement of goods or services can be effected over a specified period, but which places no obligation on IDLO to order any minimum or maximum quantity.

Each Framework Agreement will have its specified list of services, indicating the upper ceiling price agreed at the ITB stage. The upper ceiling price list (as well as discounted rates, if applicable) are provisional and are intended solely for the purposes of evaluation and comparison of Bids and to determine the upper ceiling limit in the Framework Agreement. The Contractor cannot go beyond the upper ceiling price.

After entering into a Framework Agreement, IDLO shall place order(s) on a "need basis".



IDLO shall initiate a Secondary Tender to request confirmation from the Supplier on its service availability and prices by email. The Supplier shall confirm by return email within 48 hours (including any applicable discounts).

IDLO shall make award decisions based on "lowest priced, most technically acceptable/compliant offer".

The confirmed award shall be in the form of a duly authorized Work Order. The Work Order is IDLO's commitment against Framework Agreements. The Work Order will provide information on the exact items, its quantities and unit prices (lifted from the Framework Agreement) in addition to other logistic details.

Passenger on board the vehicle will monitor the logbook to be supplied by the Contractor. Passenger will sign on before pick-up, at every destination, and sign when drop off by passenger on board. The Finance and Administrative Manager shall have a monthly review to track the movement of the vehicle in or out of Kampala and other destinations to monitor the fuel consumption.

The Contractor is responsible for the provision of Insured Vehicles, Drivers and Maintenance Services.

D. Institutional Arrangement

IDLO will ensure that the Contractor regularly carries a logbook that will be signed at every stopping point.

The Finance and Administration Team will liaise/interact/collaborate with the Contractor.

The frequency of work will be determined by travel request and number of days required outside of Kampala, in accordance with Work Orders issued.

E. Duration of the Work

IDLO will place Work Orders at least 5 days in advance of the requirement.

The Framework Agreement will initially be signed for a period of up to 12 months. IDLO is not obliged to use the services provided by the Contractor.

IDLO will review the quality of services and deliverables during the initial 12-month period of the provision of services. Subject to satisfactory performance and agreement by both parties the Framework Agreement may be extended for another 12 months.

The prices will remain unchanged during the period of contract implementation.

F. Work Location

Field Trips will always start from Kampala. Frequently visited areas include Entebbe, Wakiso, Hoima, Jinja, Tororo, Mbale, Lira, Gulu, Kitgum.

The Contractor will be required to report regularly and be intermittently present at IDLO premises.

G. Qualifications of the Successful Contractor

- 1. Minimum Qualification and Experience of the Supplier:
 - a) The Supplier shall submit a Valid Business Registration Certificate / Tax Certificate.
 - b) The Supplier shall have at least 2 Years of working experience as Vehicle Rental Services in Uganda with UN or other international equivalent organizations.



- c) The Supplier shall provide a brief company profile with reference to Business Owners, years of operations in Uganda, main office and branches, number of vehicles and types of vehicles, client list, number of staff working in the office.
- d) The Supplier shall provide CVs of the focal persons who will be responsible for operations and drivers who will be deployed to work for IDLO with their contact information.
- e) The Supplier shall provide Copies of Reference Letters from prior clients.
- f) The Supplier shall provide previous Certificates of Merit (if applicable)

2. Minimum Qualifications and Requirements for Vehicle(s):

- a) The Supplier must deploy fleet Vehicles whose models are no less than 2010 production. The Supplier must provide a list of Vehicles attached to a contracted comprehensive insurance policy.
- b) All Vehicles shall be affixed with Number Plates as required by law for use of IDLO.
- c) The Supplier must provide maintenance of the rented vehicles
- d) The Vehicles provided by the Supplier must be in fully functional and shall have tools and equipment as per <u>Annex I Standard Vehicle Equipment Checklist</u>
