Mr President,

I would like to express my gratitude for the very high level and inspiring contributions that have been shared here, today.

This is a precious jewel and we are **proud to host it in Italy**, where the very conceptualization of **law** started to flourish.

Good legislation is paramount for the thorough protection of fundamental rights and freedoms, as well as to achieve comprehensive social and economic protection, especially for the most vulnerable and with special regard to fragile countries and conflict affected countries.

Mr President,

It is in this light that we strongly recommend - in the forthcoming Strategic Plan 2017-2020 – that more attention be given to **trade and economic law** as key enablers of development, with special emphasis on land tenure, natural resources, right to food and the agricultural sector.

In this regard, we also encourage closer cooperation with the UN Rome based Agencies and the UN Committee on World Food Security.
