GLOBAL LAUNCH OF IDLO'S STRATEGIC PLAN 2021-2024: Partnering to Advance the Rule of Law in Challenging Times

Despite widespread acknowledgement of its crucial enabling role, there has been a sharp deterioration in several dimensions of the rule of law since the 2030 Agenda was adopted. This includes an increase in violence and armed conflict, large-scale humanitarian crises, growing authoritarianism, rising inequalities, intolerance and social tensions. The rule of law is further threatened by mounting pressure on international norms and standards, and attacks on human rights, the independence of the judiciary and on civil society.

COVID-19 has exacerbated these trends and has the potential to further aggravate them dramatically. For this reason, the crisis also presents a unique opportunity to reexamine assumptions, raise ambitions, and reorient the world towards a more just, peaceful and sustainable future.

On the occasion of its adoption by the <u>Assembly of Parties</u>, IDLO is launching its new Strategic Plan 2021-2024. The Plan is anchored in the 2030 Agenda and reflects IDLO's approach to the rule of law as both an outcome and enabler of peace and sustainable development.

IDLO is organizing a thematic discussion around the substantive priorities of the Strategic Plan, featuring high level speakers to discuss the challenges and opportunities for *Partnering to Advance the Rule of Law in Challenging Times.*
